SECTION 7: EMBLEM OF THE SATHYA SAI BABA CENTRAL COUNCIL OF MALAYSIA

1.0 GENERAL

- 1.1. In accordance with the Societies Act 1966, the Sathya Sai Baba Central Council of Malaysia has obtained approval to use it's emblem as the official symbol of the movement. The emblem will be used and reproduced in accordance with the approved sample to serve its purpose for all Sathya Sai Baba Centres in Malaysia. Please refer to Appendix 7A.
- 1.2. All Sathya Sai Baba Centres of Malaysia are therefore advised to strictly adhere to the specifications of the emblem, as per the sample artwork, when adoption/printing/producing flags, plaques, tie-pins, collar-pins, badges, letterheads, garments etc.

2.0 SPECIFICATION

- 2.1. The insignia will show (consists of) an opened lotus on a raised pedestal inside (bordered by) a circle (to which is) and attached with five (5) leaves and five (5) petals. The words 'Sathya' (TRUTH), 'Dharma' (RIGHTEOUSNESS), 'Shanthi' (PEACE), 'Prema' (LOVE) and 'Ahimsa' (NON-VIOLENCE) will be used/printed on the petals (Sanskrit term) and on the leaves will be used/printed the meanings in Bahasa Malaysia, English, Mandarin and Tamil, signifying the five (5) basic human values. The flag, badge, plaque, letterhead and symbol shall be in two colours i.e. the background shall be in white (signifying purity) and all the lines and words in blue (signifying divinity).
- 2.2. The colour blue should (as far as possible) be of a light shade and conform to the existing blue colour used in existing insignias and letterheads of the Sathya Sai Baba Central Council of Malaysia.
